



Welcome to the 2008 Cheerleading Season.

Good Sportsmanship is not only expected it is mandatory. We will not tolerate any unsportsmanlike conduct. As coaches and advisors we will do our best to make sure the girls have a safe and fun experience in cheerleading this year but the girls also must realize that for safety reasons our rules need to be followed. Please also read the Conduct Form on the reverse side of this paper.

For safety reasons we do have a few rules that **MUST** be followed.

1. NO FLIP FLOPS ALLOWED AT PRACTICES OR GAMES.
2. NO jewelry is to be worn at practices, games or competition.
3. NO cell phones should be turned on at practices or games. You can turn them on after practice or a game if needed.
4. A demerit sheet will be gone over with all of the girls at practice.

Competition will be held on September 13th this year. This is extremely early so attending practice is very important. Mandatory practice will start on August 28th.

If for some reason you don't feel you can bring a problem or issue to one of your child's football coaches (our high school girls are not to be brought into problems of adult situations) or cheer advisors please know you can go to any one of the organization officers, Ron Petrunich, President, Jack Reeves, Vice-President, Dan Snipes, Treasurer, Paul Sokoloski, Secretary, the cheer Coordinator Terri Curnow or Terri's Assistant Kim Bruce. We ask that if you have an issue you address it with one of these people first and you are also more than welcome to bring it to a meeting. Our organization meetings are the last Thursday of every month with the exception of July. Our meeting for July will be held on Thursday July 24th after practice at Kay's Pizza. The reason for this change is that the football players have an away scrimmage on July 31st. We encourage all parents to attend the meetings as this is where all of the decisions for the organization are made.
