Please note, any person/parent who has a problem with any activity by a coach, advisor or participant must bring it to the attention of the Governing Body, first by phone then at a monthly meeting, **NOT AT PRACTICES OR GAMES IN FRONT OF ANY OF THE CHILDREN**. We have monthly meetings for this purpose among others.

Tobacco use and alcohol use of any kind is prohibited for ALL participants, coaches, advisors, and all spectators at all LAKELAND JR. CHIEFS functions (practices, games, etc...). Keep in mind, this is a school district rule, not only a Jr. Chiefs rule.
